## Geoecological and nature-friendly aspects of Kobuleti Black Sea coast

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The present paper consists of three chapters. The object of research is the Black Sea region of Kobuleti, with the surrounding hills and foothills.

The first chapter discusses the natural environment of the area, which includes relief, climate, inland waters, soil, vegetation. The focus here is on anthropogenic transformation and aspects of environmental conservation, restoration and reproduction. Landscapes and their current state are also discussed.

The second chapter reflects the transformation of the natural environment by discussing natural disasters, ecological problems in the atmosphere. This chapter also discusses the Black Sea and its ecological problems.

The third chapter analyzes landscape potential, nature use and environmental optimization issues.

Recommendations and conclusions are given at the end of the paper.

The research is based on a multi-component approach that uses descriptive, cartographic, field and comparative analysis. GIS technologies are also used for cartographic analysis.
