

Cartographic-Geographic analysis of political-administrative map of
Caucasus in 1903

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The present master's thesis discusses the political-administrative map of the Caucasus (1903) as well as cartographic-geographical analysis. The paper consists of five parts: The first part discusses the research map encryption - some issues of registration and discusses it in detail.

The second part includes changes in the administrative arrangement of Georgia and territorial transformations (from the ancient period to the XIX century).

The third part is dedicated to the variability between the state border of Georgia in 1903 and the modern border of Shire.

The fourth and fifth parts talk about the administrative division and the settlements on the survey map. The research conducted by the author and the theoretical materials according to which the present master's thesis has been strengthened allow us to analyze the information that is read on the map.
